Procedure

Submitting the application

The application for the licence to possess prop firearms must be submitted to the relevant police department of the place of activity (storage); in Budapest, the Budapest Police Headquarters.

Costs and expenses of the procedure

The administrative service fee payable for the application for the licence to possess prop firearms shall be HUF 13,000, additionally a fee of HUF 2,000 shall be payable for each firearm. An additional HUF 2,000 of service fee shall be payable for authorising each employee as a person liable for handling the firearms, and a fee also payable for issuing a permit for firearms storage shall be as follows:

- HUF 15,000 for up to 25 firearms,
- HUF 35.000 for between 26 and 50 firearms.
- HUF 45,000 for 50+ firearms.

The administrative service fee is payable to the appropriation allocation bank account held by the relevant county police department in charge of the police department initially involved; in Budapest, the Budapest Police Headquarters. The payment must be effected not later than on the business day following the receipt of the registration number issued by the relevant authority. In the description of the payment the reason of the payment (*filmgyártási fegyver tartása iránti kérelem* – application for requesting licence to possess prop firearms) together with the registration number of the case (registration number: 'RZSEIR' registration number indicated in the communication sent by the document management system of the Police to the applicant's Customer Gateway storage spacel) must be indicated.

The bank account numbers are contained in Appendix 2 of D.

Attachments to be added to the application submitted in pdf files

- the documents to certify the special conditions as specified in G.d.;
- in the case of employees test certificate evidencing the applicant's theoretical knowledge and practical skills required to possess firearms (firearms safety certificate) and certificate of the preliminary medical assessment (issued by the relevant occupational health authority). The examination/assessment has a medical and a psychological component;
- a sketch and security description of the firearms storage facility, if available.

Processing the application

If during processing the application it is established that the entitled applicant has submitted the complete application to the authority having appropriate jurisdiction, or the applicant has complied with the request for correction or amendment, and the conditions of granting the licence as required by the law have been met, the authority shall grant, in a form of a decision, a licence to possess prop firearms. The licence to possess prop firearms and the official card evidencing the licence (document/card) can be collected by the licence holder in person via their authorised trade representative from the licensing police authority during business hours.
