Procedure

Organisations whose main tasks include private security activities including the protection of the employing party's or their own assets, physical safety and integrity may be approved to hold a licence to possess firearms, if they can prove that the execution of their tasks necessitates the possession of short firearms.

Submitting the application

The application for the licence to possess firearms for personal and property protection must be submitted to the relevant police department of the location of the activity (storage); in Budapest, the Budapest Police Headquarters.

Costs and expenses of the procedure

The administrative service fee payable for the licence to possess the first firearm shall be:

- licence to possess firearms in case of organisations HUF 3,000 for each weapon
- contribution to employ personnel possessing firearms and ammunition, and licence issued for personnel HUF 2,000 for each person
- permits for storage of firearms, ammunition, ammunition component storage:
- HUF 15,000 for up to 25 firearms and/or up to 5000 pcs. of ammunition;
- HUF 35,000 for between 26 and 50 firearms and/or 10,000 pcs. of ammunition;
- HUF 45,000 for 50+ firearms and/or 10,000 pcs. of ammunition;
- ammunition component storage: HUF 35,000.
- HUF 4,000 for the exchange and replacement of licences to possess firearms.

The administrative service fee payable for extension:

- HUF 2,500 for up to 10 firearms.
- HUF 4,500 for between 11 to 25 firearms
- HUF 7,000 for 25+ firearms
- HUF 2,000 for each employee

The administrative service fee is payable to the appropriation allocation bank account held by the relevant county police department initially involved; in Budapest, the Budapest Police Headquarters. The payment must be effected not later than on the business day following the receipt of the registration number issued by the relevant authority. In the description of the payment the reason for the payment (*személy- és vagyonvédelmi célú lőfegyver tartása iránti kérelem* – application for requesting a licence to possess short firearms for personal and property protection) together with the registration number of the case (registration number: 'RZSEIR' registration number indicated in the communication sent by the document management system of the Police to the applicant's Customer Gateway storage space) must be indicated.

Attachments to be added to the application submitted in pdf files

application proving that the firearms are necessary to execute their tasks

- (for instance: in case of own assets, invoices proving cash flow; in case of protection of the employing party's assets, the contract proving work executed by carrying firearms);
- in case of employees test certificate evidencing the applicant's theoretical knowledge and practical skills required to possess firearms (firearms safety certificate) and certificate of the preliminary medical assessment (issued by the relevant occupational health authority). The examination/assessment has a medical and a psychological component;
- a sketch and security description of the firearms storage facility, if available.

Processing the application

If during processing the application it is established that the entitled applicant has submitted the complete application to the authority having appropriate jurisdiction, or the applicant has complied with the request for correction or amendment, the storage facility, upon the inspection carried out on site, meets the requirements set in G. d., and that furthermore, there are no reasons set in Arms Act that may exclude granting the licence, the authority shall grant, in a form of a decision, a licence to possess firearms. The authority shall issue a licence to possess firearms (licence), which is valid for 5 years. Upon application, the validity of the licence can be prolonged for additional 5 years if the licence holder submits his/her application 30 days prior to expiry.

The licence to possess firearms for personal and property protection and the official card evidencing the licence (document/card) can be collected by the licence holder in person via their authorised trade representative from the licensing police authority during business hours.
