Procedure

Manufacturing weapons, ammunition (cartridge) and ammunition components may be authorised for sole traders and organisations.

Submitting the application

Applications for requesting a licence to manufacture weapons, ammunition (cartridge) and ammunition components must be submitted to the relevant county police department of the place of activity of the organisation or enterprise; in Budapest, the Budapest Police Headquarters.

Costs and expenses of the procedure

The administrative service fee for the application for a licence to manufacture weapons, ammunition (cartridge) and ammunition components shall be HUF 150,000. The administrative service fee for the necessary permits to employ personnel in the manufacturing process shall be HUF 2,000 for each person. Where no such stipulations exist as set out in section 6 of Annex I of D., the administrative service fee for the application for a licence to store firearms, ammunition and ammunition components shall be as follows:

- HUF 15,000 for up to 25 firearms and/or ammunition up to 5000 pcs.;
- HUF 35,000 for between 26–50 firearms and/or 10,000 pcs. of ammunition;
- HUF 45,000 for 50+ firearms and/or 10,000 pcs. of ammunition;
- ammunition component storage: HUF 35,000.

The administrative service fee is payable to the appropriation allocation bank account held by the relevant county police department in the first instance; in Budapest, the Budapest Police Headquarters. The payment must be effected not later than on the business day following the receipt of the registration number issued by the relevant authority. In the description of the payment the reason for the payment (*fegyver gyártása iránti kérelem* – application to request a licence to manufacture weapons) together with the registration number of the case (registration number: 'RZSEIR' registration number indicated in the communication sent by the document management system of the Police to the applicant's Customer Gateway storage space) must be indicated.

The bank account numbers are contained in Appendix 2 of D.

Attachments to be added to the application submitted in pdf files

1.

- the to-scale layout of the building;
- the method of separating the premises for carrying out the activity from the premises for storage;
- the details and the technical approvals of the security system (steel security bars, impact resistant security foils, alarm system, etc.);
- a test certificate evidencing the employees' theoretical knowledge and practical skills;
- the copy of the licence to operate as a sole trader or, failing that, the registration number of the licence; documents verifying qualifications.

2. If available, the expert opinion of the organisation entitled (designated) to inspect firearms and ammunition, which shall contain as follows:

- the statements made in accordance with the methods and process of inspections carried out on the operational safety of small firearms for civilian use and of ammunition, as set

out in the national standard of MSZ 15765, as well as the classification of cartridges, as set out in the national standard of MSZ 15764, of the particular firearms, gas and alarm weapons and ammunition, respectively;

- if the weapon, ammunition (cartridge) and ammunition component meet the requirements of this decree, the opinion shall also contain the other important statements, regarding operational safety and the legitimate use, of the weapon, ammunition (cartridge) and ammunition components;
- in the case of weapons, ammunition (cartridge) and ammunition components subject to inspection for approval of the type of production documentation (layout, production method and technology used);
- the details of the firearms, weapons, ammunition (cartridge) and ammunition components (type and characteristics), their quantities and the size of inventories;
- the date of commencement of manufacturing.

The applicant, if called upon by the authority, must produce the original copy of the attached documents.

Processing the application

If during processing the application it is established that the entitled applicant has submitted the complete application to the authority having appropriate jurisdiction, or the applicant has complied with the request for correction or amendment, the premises for storage, upon the inspection carried out on site, meet the requirements set in G. d., furthermore there are no reasons set out in Arms Act that may exclude the applicant from being granted the licence, the authority shall make a decision of granting a licence to carry out manufacturing activities. The Police shall then send the applicant the electronically certified copy of the decision on the permit. The firearm distributor permit (document in a card-format) shall be received, in accordance with the declaration made by the customer, either by mail or in person during business hours.
