Procedural order

Submission of the exclusion request

In the breach proceedings, the exclusion request (hereinafter referred to as "the application"), is - in the cases specified by law – directed to transfer proceedings to another authority or person able to take an unbiased decision in the matter instead of the current authority acting upon it. The request is sent to the authority currently responsible for the case, which suspends its proceedings after receiving the application, until the re-assessment of the case by the newly appointed authority electronic attachments may accompany the request.

Receipt of the application

Applications and attachments submitted electronically through the client Gateway are forwarded to the document management system of the Police via the central electronic service system. The client receives notification thereof from the central electronic service system. The application and its attachments automatically reach the authority that they are addressed to via the document management system of the Police and the applicant receives an automatic notification of the fact. Lack of an automatic notification from the document management system of the Police means that the application and its attachments have not reached the relevant authority. In that case it is suggested that the applicant contact the relevant authority by telephone.

Processing the application

If the relevant authority examining the application determines the existence of the conditions laid down in the law, it shall exclude the authority currently acting on the case and simultaneously appoint an alternative authority which will be required to carry out the proceedings. The excluded authority in the case must not continue the proceedings and is obliged to immediately send the documents of the case to the newly appointed authority in order that they may carry out the proceedings. If, on the basis of the request, the exclusion of the authority currently in the case is not justified, the request shall be rejected by a decision of the relevant authority. An electronically authenticated copy of the decision shall be issued and forwarded to the applying client's Gateway storage space. No personal appearance is usually required when considering the application.
