Submitting the application:

Enterprises eligible to submit an application for a licence have to submit the application to the county (or Budapest) police headquarters relevant to the location of their registered office.

Enterprises eligible to submit an application for a licence: enterprises (sole traders, companies, single member companies) where the member/employee personally involved in pursuing or controlling the pyrotechnic activity for civilian use or at least one of its employees or a person

performing activities for the enterprise on the basis of a civil law contract is a pyrotechnician complying with the requirements specified in section “Regulations concerning pyrotechnic activities for civilian use” of the Arms Act.

The pursuit of the activity is conditional on a licence authorising the pyrotechnic activity relevant for the transaction, or, in the case of export, a written purchase declaration by the addressee.

Processing the application

If during the processing of the application it is established that an eligible customer has submitted a fully completed application to the relevant authority or has complied with the request for supplying missing items and the conditions of lawful, safe pyrotechnic activity are met, the Police shall issue a decision authorising the activity.
